Should this type of behavior continue then Hibaldstow Parish Council will be left with no choice but to remove the equipment, this would be a real shame not only for the local children but for the wider community.

Humberside Police and Hibaldstow Parish Council wish to work with local community to help identify those person/s responsible for the issues that are being experienced in the park, together we can make the park a safer, cleaner place for our children to play.
